What is Narcan?

Naloxone (commonly known by the brand name Narcan) is a medication approved by the FDA to prevent overdose by opioids such as heroin, morphine, and oxycodone. It blocks opioid receptor sites, reversing the toxic effects of the overdose. This training will teach you how to recognize and reverse an opioid overdose.

Opioid overdose-related deaths are **reduced by half** in communities that have access to naloxone.
